Travellers Tales Told in Little Landscapes

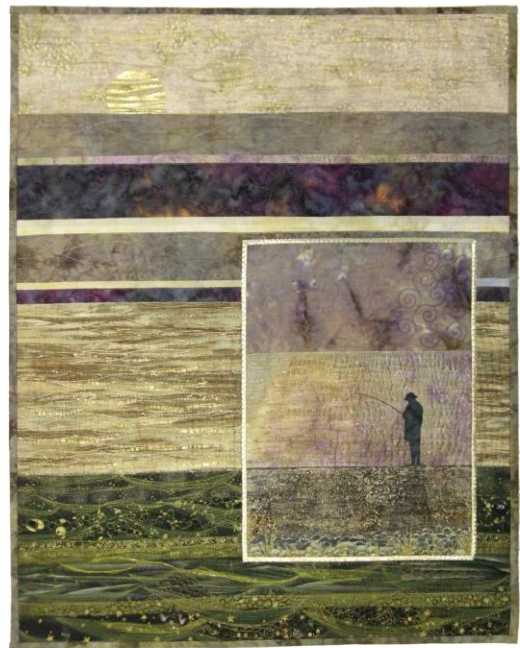
Conjure up the atmosphere and capture memories of special places by creating strata of fabric layers. With the strata in place, superimpose a tiny, pictorial glimpse or detail of the scene. These pieces are A4 sized, achievable and manageable.

Requirements

Please note that I will bring a variety of kits that contain an inspirational image and all the fabrics and embellishments that you need to complete the project for £15/€22. This means that you can use this workshop as a prototype and learn all the techniques and then go on to develop the ideas in your own way afterwards.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING TO THE WORKSHOP

- Add-a-Quarter ruler – this is a yellow ruler about 1” wide with a ¼” lip on it.
- Machine and hand embroidery threads
- Metallic machine threads, gold and silver
- Jeans stitch and metallic machine needles
- Pencil
- 505 Basting Spray
- Baking parchment
- Some sheets of A4 paper
- Usual sewing kit
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- Sewing machine with all attachments, walking foot, foot control, extension lead and instruction book
- Iron (one between two should avoid queues) and ironing pad/board
- Teflon sheet if you have one/baking parchment



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
