## **Materials and Equipment**

- To inspire you: a copy or photograph (A4 size) of a landscape.
- Sewing machine (note: the sewing machine with accessories is only used when there is still time), sewing kit, cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter.
- Darning Foot, foot base and possibly a cord foot.
- Sewing threads. Matching needles.
- Acrylic Felt (ecru) to the meter ± 35x35 cm. Lutradur ± 35 x 25 cm. Inform the relevant store if you can buy these two different materials. If not: you can order it for me (preferably 4 weeks in advance).
- ✤ Glue-on battig from Hobbs, ± 35 x 35cm.
- Vliesofix ± 25 x 25 cm and baking paper.
- Black cotton or other dark color ± 25 x 25 cm. Backing fabric 35x 35 cm.
- Beads, sequins, buttons.
- Embroidery Yarn, wool yarn, needle.
- Merino Wool (about a sandwich bag filled with a few colors, for wet felting), old towel, paper towels, dish brush, barbecue skewer, piece of bubble wrap 40 x 40 cm and 2 plastic sandwich bags.
- Silk materials like coco neat, silk rods, silk hankies (a few colors) If you don't want to work with silk hankies, then please bring ± 100 g merino wool (in a few colors / shades, for dry felting).
- To create a flowery landscape: please take a few colors of synthetic organza.
- 5 frequency filter (needle felting tool) by clover for manual punch or a punch machine if you have it in your possession.
- 1 large brush mat (clover) (only purchase this item if you do not own a punch machine)
- 2 Neocolor II watersoluble crayons, color turquoise blue and mauve (violet), these crayons are available at art-stores (I also bring a few).
- Pen and paper for notes.
- NB Choose materials and colours that match in colour and intensity.
